



Net 3: Making Connections in English

Nelson Thornes Ltd, U.S.A., 2001. Soft cover. Book Condition: New. This is the third of three full-colour pupil anthologies designed to support the teaching of English to 11-14 year olds. Net 3 is aimed at Year 9/S2. The Net strategy aims to encourage reading a wide range of texts, connecting between different texts and organizing information effectively. This volume contains genre-based, text-led collections reflecting the emphasis on how language is used and what effects it achieves. It has rich and varied design to encourage students to read across the wide range of materials required at Key Stage 3 (S1/S2). It uses carefully selected extracts (literary and non-literary, pre- and post-1914, familiar and more unusual) accompanied by examples of the key language skills. The choice of texts is informed by an awareness of their appeal to boys as well as girls in order to meet concerns about raising standards. It has built in cross-referencing on a thematic and linguistic basis to highlight links and facilitate mini-projects. The series strategy is underpinned by networks (concept maps) as an aid to organize information and ideas in an effective and memorable way.



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
