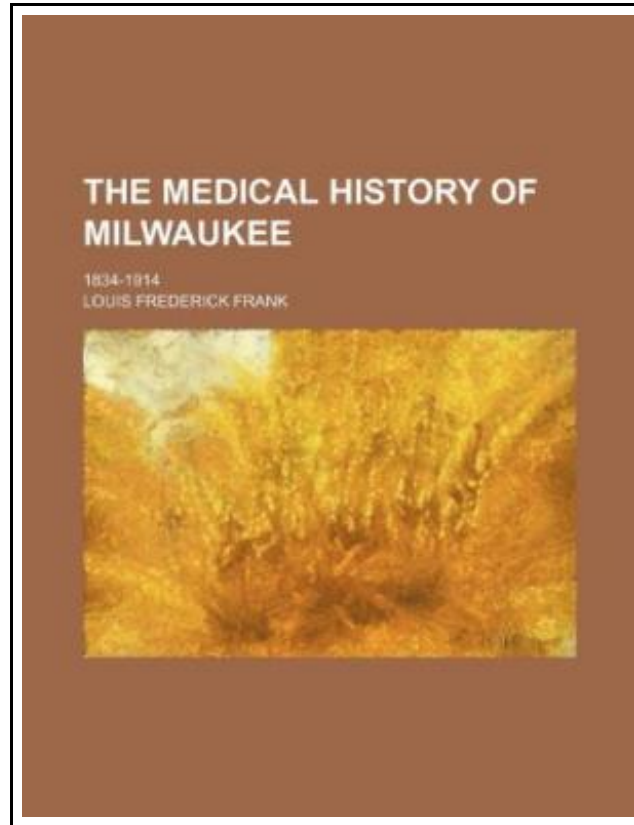

The Sisters of Charity, proposing the establishment of a benevolent institution for the sick, requested the co-operation of the society, which appointed twelve of their number to serve for one year.
